Again, this January, our AWANA club will collect new born items for the Pregnancy Resource Center.



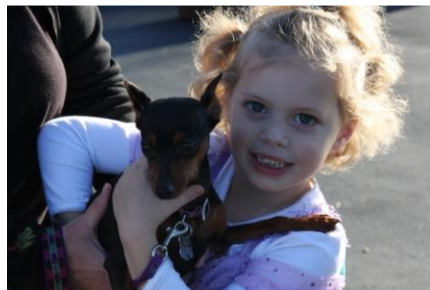
Fall Festival

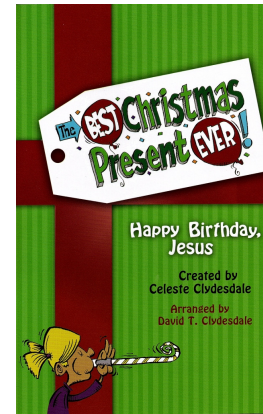
